Dayanand College, Hisar Student Satisfaction Survey for the year 2018-19

A Student satisfaction survey (SSS) was conducted under criterion II of teaching learning and evaluation for the session 2018-19. For this purpose, a prescribed format was provided to the students of different classes by the college. The provided format contained 17 questions with 5 options each. The options showed the grading for teaching learning process as it started with the excellent level which was followed by medium level and ended with poor level. Majority of the questions in this survey were related with the performance of teachers in the classroom in order to evaluate the teaching learning process. The skills of teachers, their preparation for class teaching etc. were mainly considered for this evaluation process. Questions related to the completion of syllabus in a given time frame by the teachers were also included in the proforma. Tests of the students regarding their Internal Assessment were also taken into consideration in this provided format. Some questions covered the effectiveness of the help provided by the mentor, because mentor plays a very important role for students. Questions on the beneficial use of various ICT tools like LED, Projector, PPT, Whatsaap and Internet etc. were also included in this format, to find out the effectiveness of teaching. To find out the efficiency of teachers regarding the identification of weak students, some questions were framed like taking of extra classes for weak students by the teachers. A student's personality can be improved by his/her involvement in cocurricular activities organised by different departments of the college like Poster making contest, Quiz contest, Slogan writing competition, Rangoli contest, Debate, Photography competition etc. A good teacher always encourages and motivates the students to become a part of these activities. The role of teachers was assessed through different questions in this survey. At the end of the questionnaire, the questions were asked regarding the overall quality of teaching learning process of the institute. On the basis of the options chosen by the students for different questions, the evaluation of the survey was done. Result of evaluation shows that 80% students choose option-I and 18% choose option- 2. Similarly, about 4% opted for option-3 while only 0.7% go for option-4. Likewise, option-5 was chosen by approx. 0.3% students. In this survey, option-1 for each question represents superior quality of teaching by the teachers, which is adopted by majority of the students. Thus, this survey clearly shows that students are highly satisfied with the teaching learning procedures opted by the teachers. It also indicated that the institute is going in right direction by providing a superior quality of teaching learning environment to their students.
