for the year 2019-20

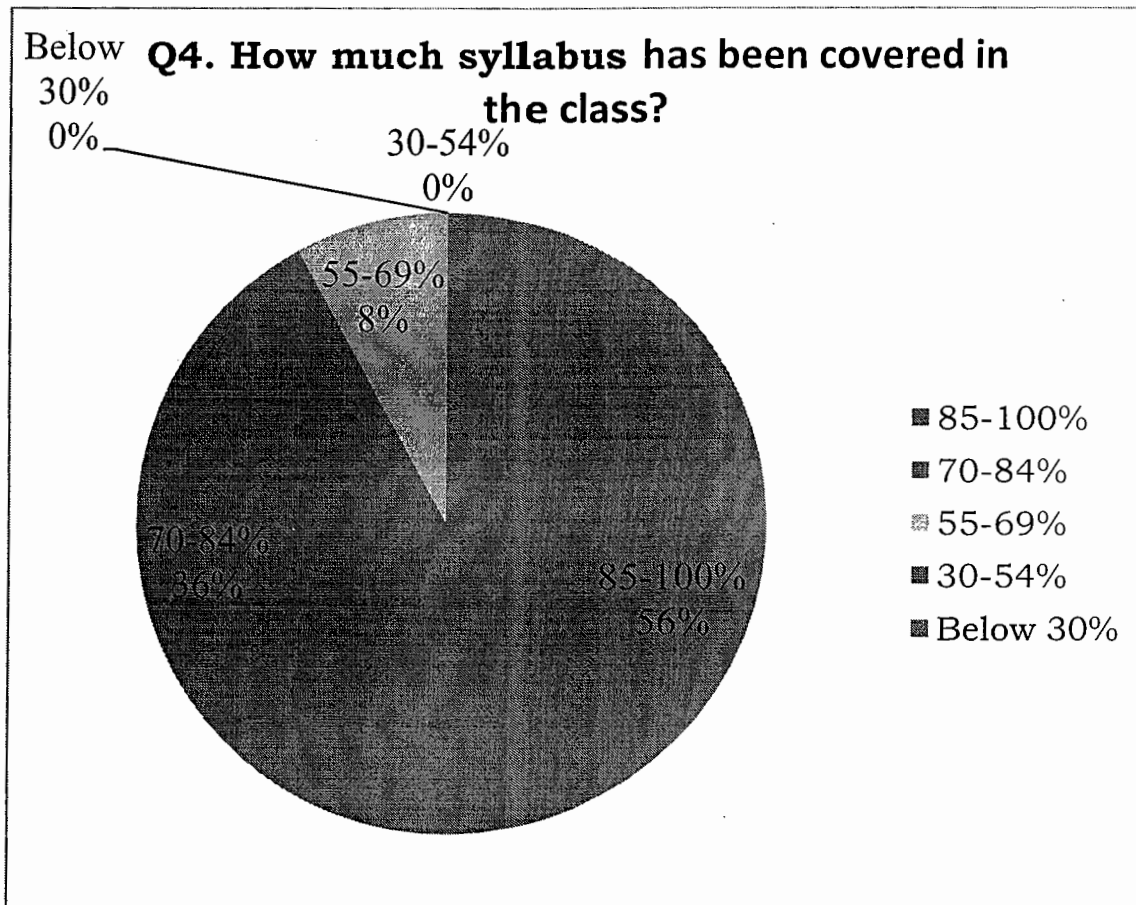

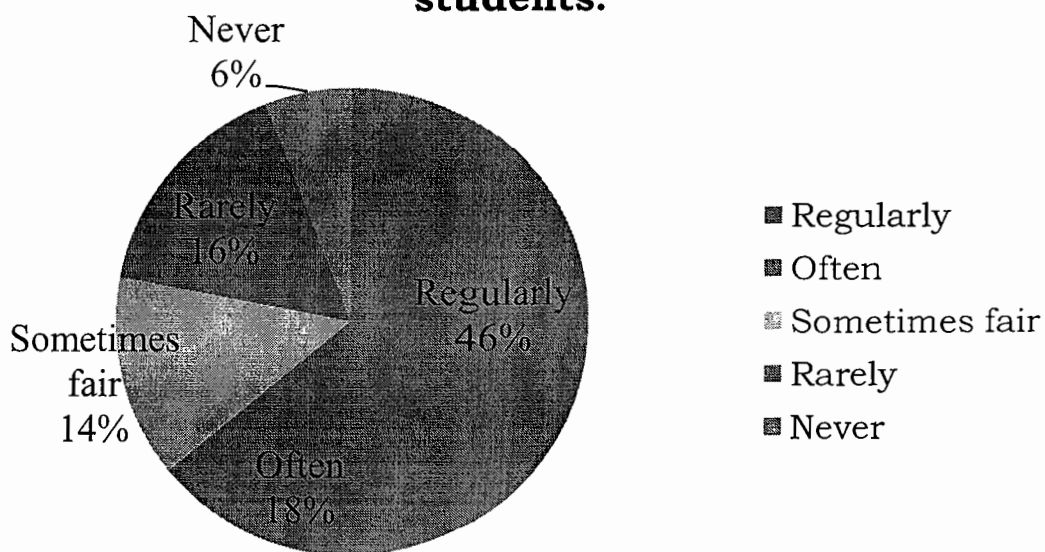

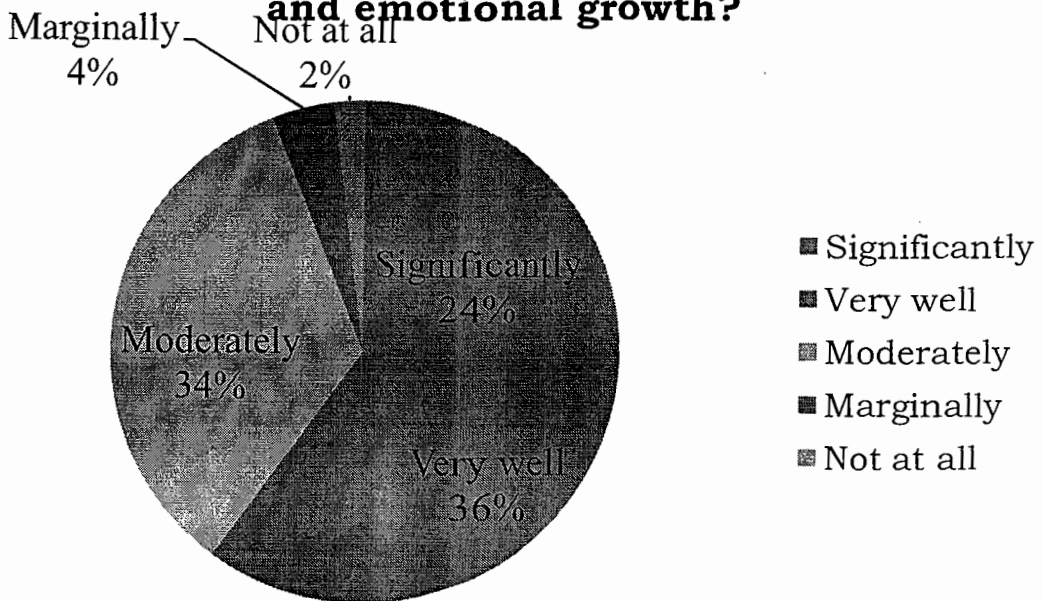

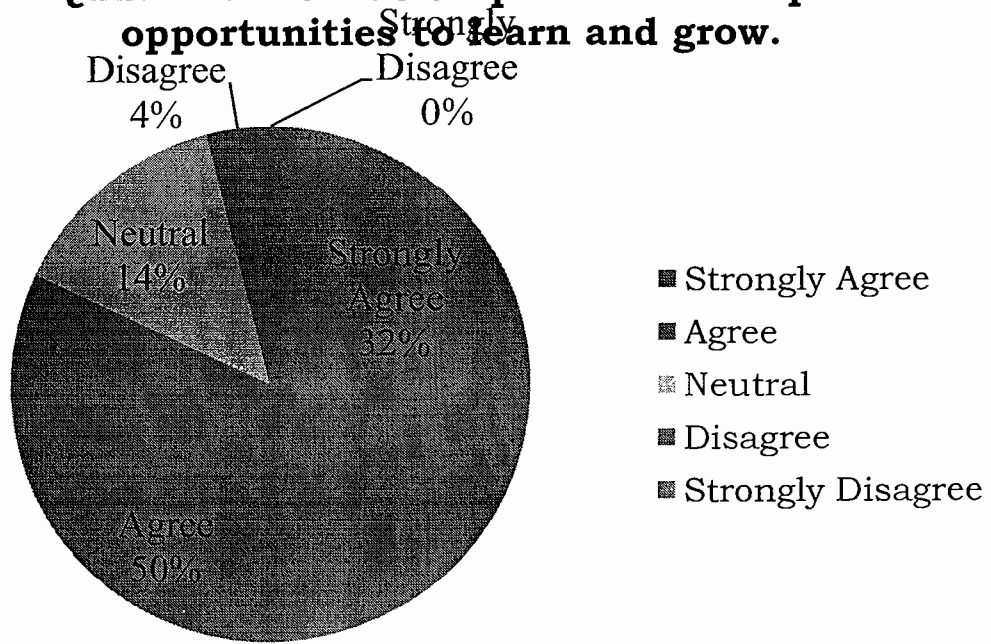

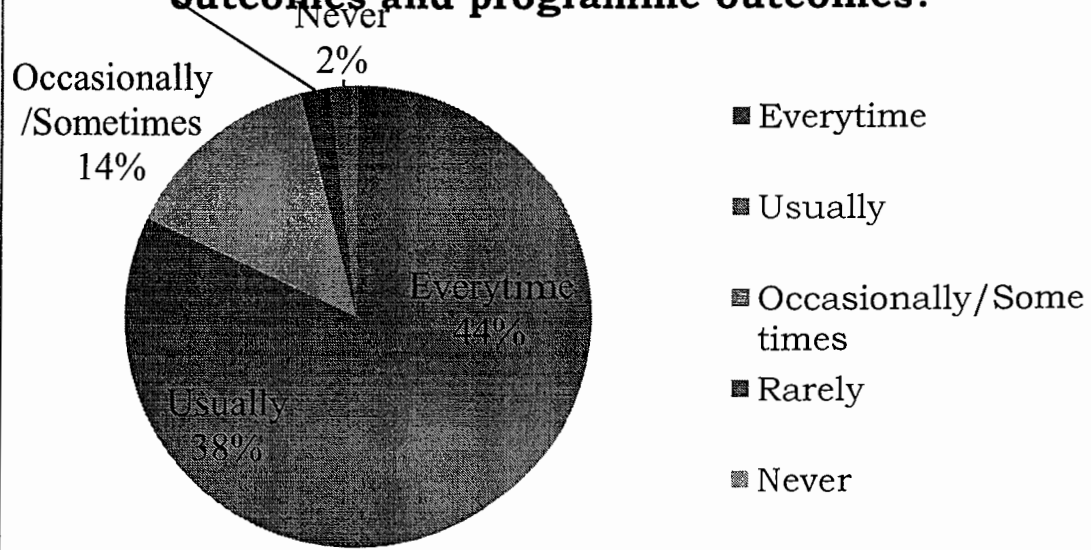

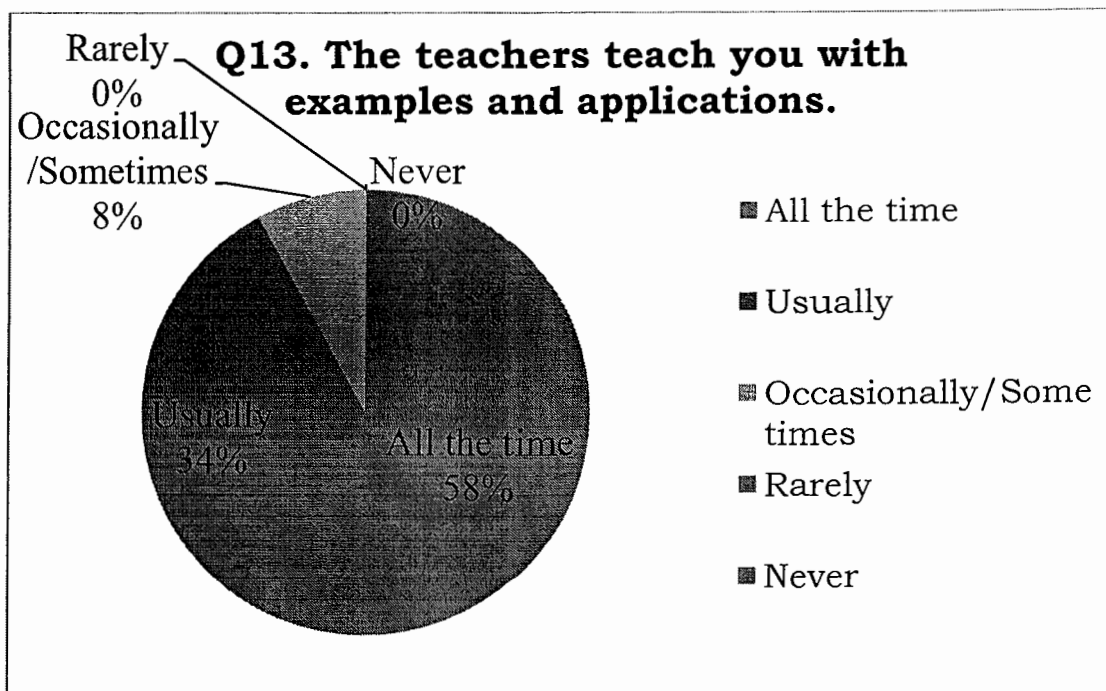


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Q12. Are you informed by your teachers about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes?

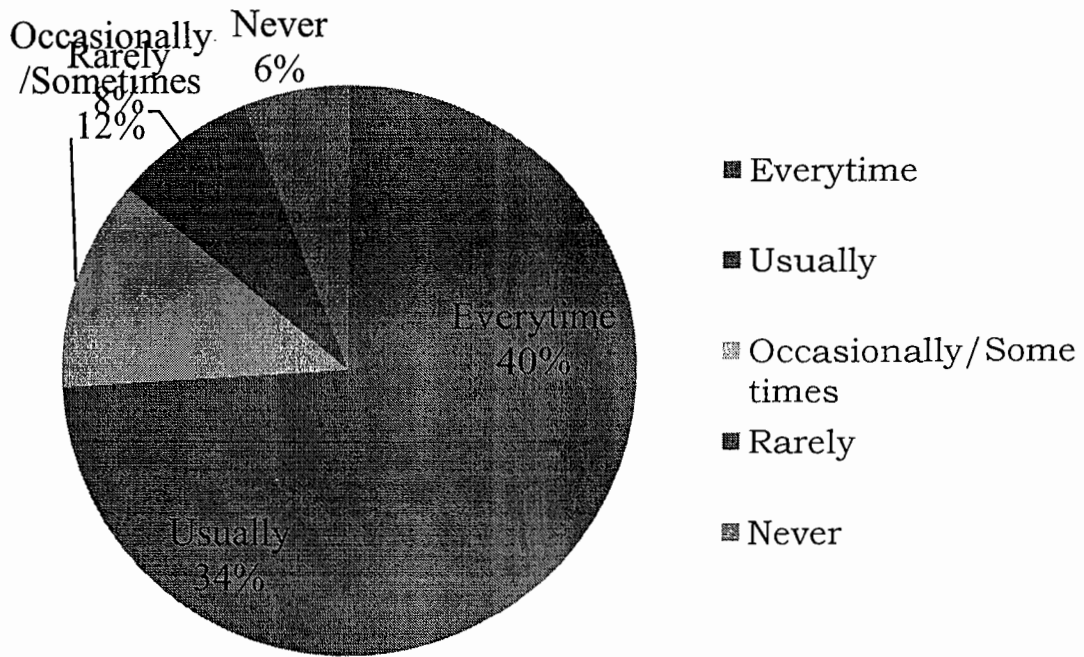


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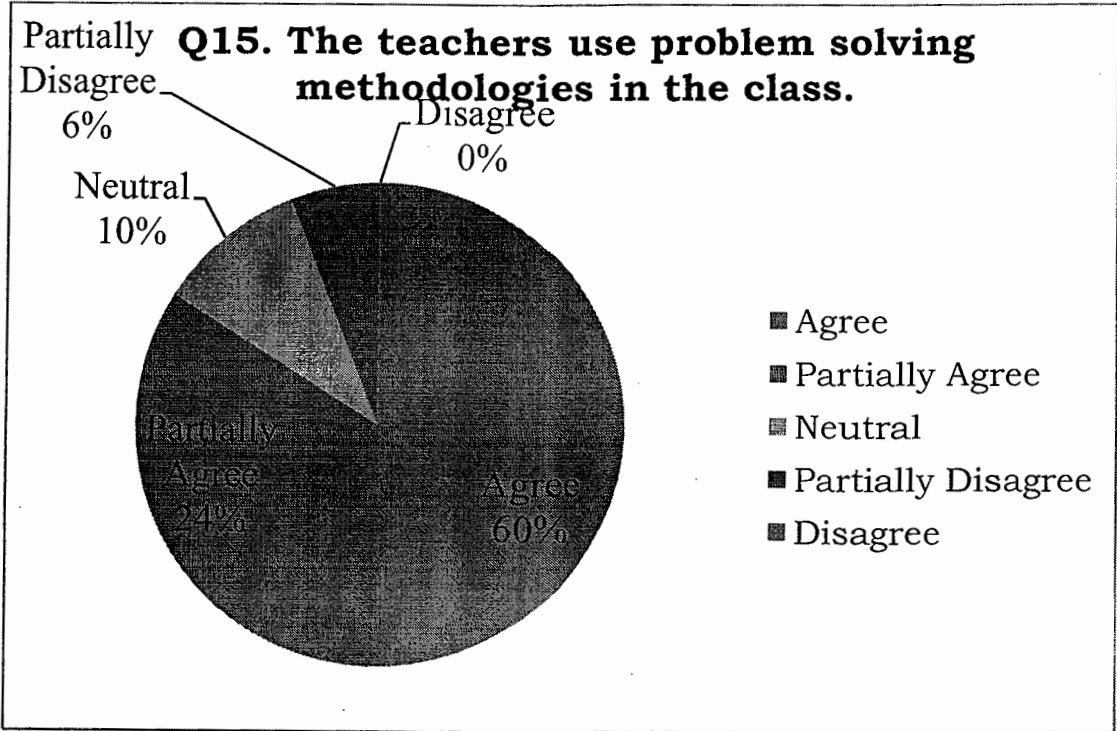

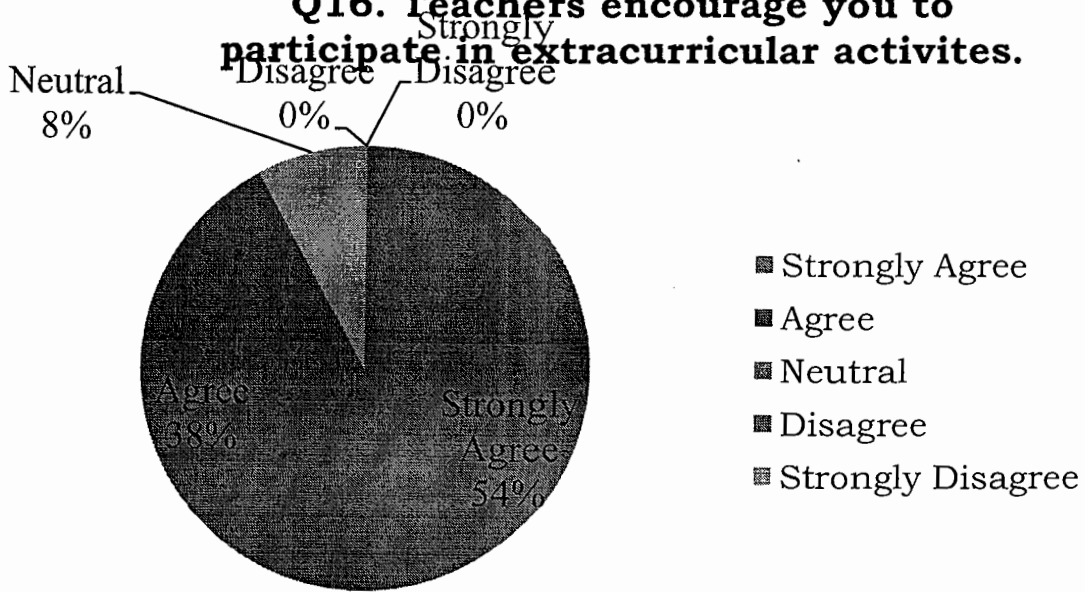

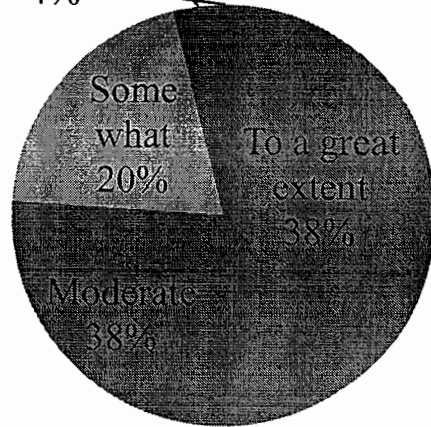

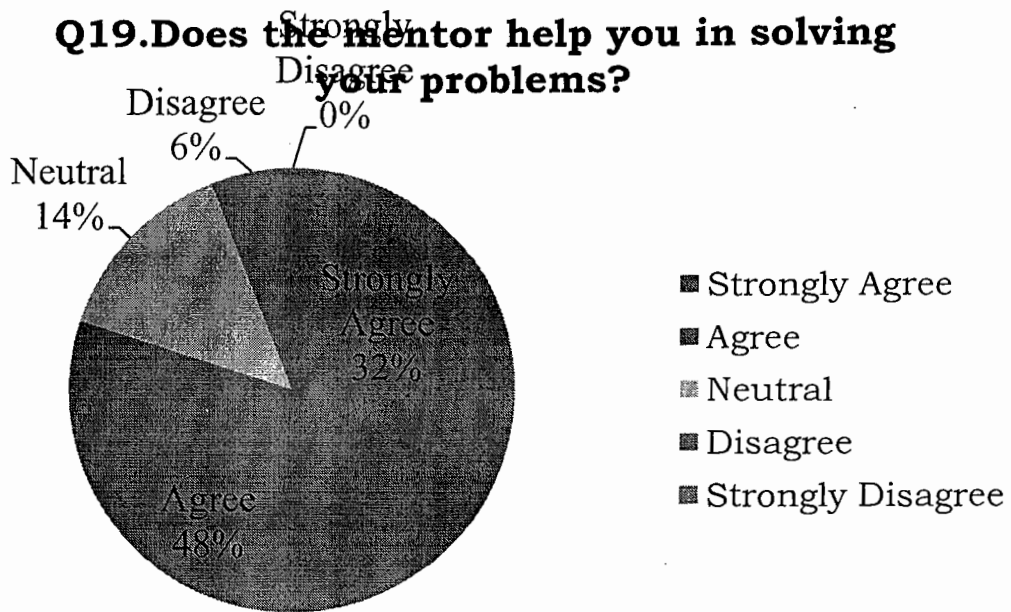
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Q18. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching.



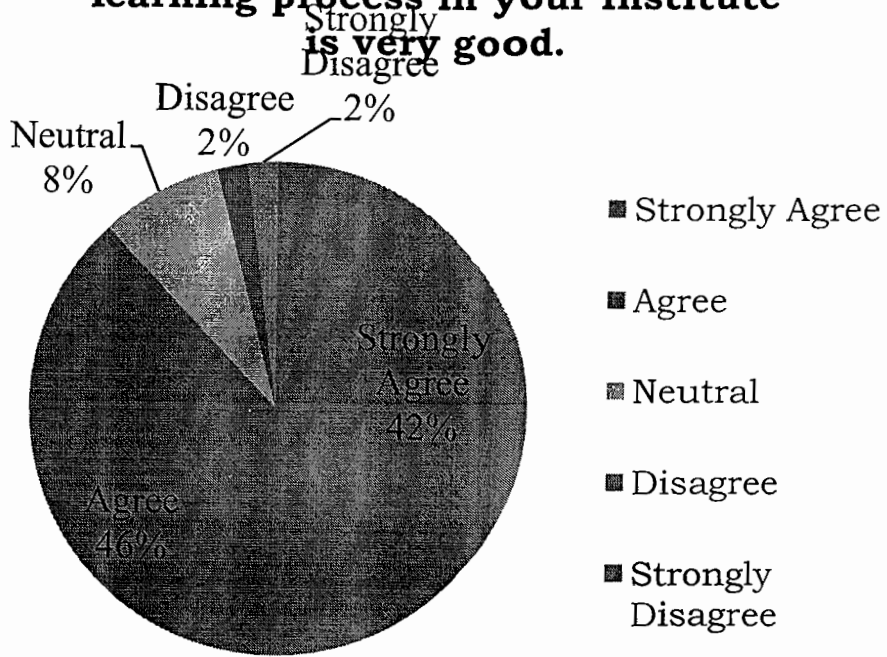




