


Dayannad College, Hisar Student's Satisfaction Survey Report for the year 2019-20










Q10. How does the teaching and mentoring process facilitates you in social Marginally_Not at all

























Q18. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching.
