ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Dayanand College, Hisar is a 76 years old, Re-Accredited as 'A++' Grade institution by NAAC, Bengaluru in June 2024. The temple of learning is a nursery of higher education. The college owes its existence to the vision and missionary zeal of Lala Gian Chand Mahajan (later venerated as Swami Munishwaranand) who was a teacher by profession, a social crusader by inclination, and a saint by temperament. Swamiji was helped in his crusade by a galaxy of philanthropists and missionaries. The college is a multi-faculty, co-educational government-aided institution affiliated to Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar.

Semester of the UG programme. Such student shall pass the compartment/re-appear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the concerned UG Programme. If a student does not clear the compartment/re-appear subject even before the commencement of the 1st semester examination, her/his provisional admission to concerned UG Programme shall be cancelled ab initio by the Chairperson/Principal/Director with intimation to the University. However, the Vice-Chancellor may relax this condition, in exceptional cases, oneself or on the recommendations of a committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

For such students, the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by considering the minimum pass marks in compartment/re-appear subject.

- (ii) A candidate having 2-Year Diploma from ITI or 3-Year Diploma from Polytechnic of minimum 2 years duration qualified with Hindi Core/ English as one subject or as an additional subject at Class XII level is also eligible for seeking admission in First Semester of the UG Programme in Arts discipline or in the disciplines wherever mentioned so.

Further, in case of Equivalence of Diploma Courses of Technical Education Department Haryana OR ITI Certificate Courses of Skill Development and Industrial Training Department, Haryana, the General Instructions/ Guidelines of State Government for admission to various courses in affiliated colleges/ institutes will be applicable.

Bachelor of Science in Physical Sciences

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the Undergraduate (UG) Programme. In addition, the following conditions, if applicable should also be satisfied:

- to opt for Mathematics as a Discipline Specific Courses (DSC), the candidate must have passed Mathematics as a subject in the qualifying examination.
- to opt for Chemistry as a DSC, the candidate must have passed Chemistry as a subject in the qualifying examination.
- to opt for Physics as a DSC, the candidate must have passed Physics as a subject in the qualifying examination
- to opt for Computer Science/ Geography / Electronics as a DSC, the candidate must have passed Mathematics as a subject in the qualifying examination in Science stream.

Further, eligibility conditions for admission to a programme shall be applicable as mentioned in the scheme of the concerned programme, if any.

Note: It will be the sole responsibility of the Principal and the Admission Committee of the college concerned to ensure that the subject(s) mentioned above, if taken as DSC must have passed as a subject in qualifying examinations. The university will only verify the minimum eligibility of the qualifying examination for Registration in the programme concerned.

For Bachelor of Science with Major in <subject>

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the Undergraduate (UG) Programme. In addition, the following conditions, if applicable should also be satisfied:

- to opt for subjects of Bachelor of Science with Major in <subject> the candidate must have passed respective subject in the qualifying examinations i.e. 10+2 in said stream.

Note:-

Common for B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) and Bachelor of Science with Major in <subject>

- (i) A student who has been placed under compartment or allowed to re-appear in one subject only in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana, or equivalent examination of another University/Board may be allowed to study provisionally for the First Semester of the UG programme. Such student shall pass the compartment/re-appear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the concerned UG Programme. If a student does not clear the compartment/re-appear subject even before the commencement of the 1st semester examination, her/his provisional admission to concerned UG Programme shall be cancelled ab initio by the Chairperson/Principal/Director with intimation to the University. However, the Vice-Chancellor may relax this condition, in exceptional cases, oneself or on the recommendations of a committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

For such students, the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by considering the minimum pass marks in compartment/re-appear subject.

Bachelor of Science in Life Sciences

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the Undergraduate (UG) Programme. In addition, the following conditions, if applicable should also be satisfied:

- to opt for subject(s) in the discipline of Life Sciences, which consists of Botany, Zoology, Biotechnology as a one or more than one subject(s), then the candidate must have passed Class XII with Biology as a subject.
- to opt for Chemistry as a Discipline Specific Course (DSC), the candidate must have passed Chemistry as a subject in the qualifying examination.

Further, eligibility conditions for admission to a programme shall be applicable as mentioned in the scheme of the concerned programme, if any.

It will be the sole responsibility of the Principal and the Admission Committee of the college concerned to ensure that the subject(s) mentioned above, if taken as DSC must have passed as a subject in qualifying examinations. The university will only verify the minimum eligibility of the qualifying examination for Registration in the programme concerned.

Note:-

- (i) A student who has been placed under compartment or allowed to re-appear in one subject only in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana, or equivalent examination of another University/Board may be allowed to study provisionally for the First Semester of the UG programme. Such student shall pass the compartment/re-appear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the concerned UG Programme. If a student does not clear the compartment/re-appear subject even before the commencement of the 1st semester examination, her/his provisional admission to concerned Programme shall be cancelled ab initio by the Chairperson/Principal/Director with intimation to the University. However, the Vice-Chancellor may relax this condition, in exceptional cases, oneself or on the recommendations of a committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

For such students, the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by considering the minimum pass marks in compartment/re-appear subject.

Bachelor of Science (Sports)

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana with five subjects including English as one of the subject; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the Programme. In addition, the following conditions, if applicable should also be satisfied:

1. has attained the age between 17 years and 20 years on 31st December of the year of admission (relax able upto 25 years in the case of National/ Institutional Sports Persons or Members of Scheduled Caste/Tribe).
2. has participated in Sports and Games in State Level which may be State Schools/ State Inter-Districts and State Inter-College (Intermediate) and
3. has passed any one of the following examinations with English as one of the subject shall be eligible to join Semester-1 of B.Sc. Sports:
 - A. 10+2 from Board of School Education, Haryana with five subjects including English as one of the subjects OR an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto.
