# TEACHING LEARNING FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS 

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# Student's Feedback for Teaching-Learning (Session 2018-19) 

Student's feedback has become a widely used method to evaluate and improve teaching effectiveness. Feedback from the students allows the colleges to know what the college is doing that facilitates learning and what kind of adjustments are needed to be made. Even minor changes in the class room can make a huge difference. In order to get feedback from the students about 519 Questionnaires/form based on different aspects like course content, teaching learning process and evaluation process were distributed among the students. Out of these fifty forms were randomly selected and analyzed and it was found that majority of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher communicates clearly and possesses deep knowledge of the subject, guides the students for higher academic pursuits and career advancements, relates the course material with real world situations, is helpful and friendly towards students and has professional competence and is a role model for them. As every coin has two sides in the same it has been found that few students remained neutral or disagreed to the above mentioned facts.

- $64 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that teacher covers the entire syllabus whereas none disagrees.
- $50 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that teacher discusses topics in detail whereas none disagrees.
- $54 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher possesses deep knowledge of the subject taught whereas none disagrees.
- $62 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher communicates clearly whereas none disagrees.
- $46 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teachers inspire them by his/her knowledge in the subject whereas $4 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $70 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that teacher is punctual to the class whereas $2 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $42 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher engages the class for the full duration and completes the course in time whereas none of the students disagree.
- $64 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher comes fully prepared for the class whereas $2 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $54 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher provides guidance and counseling in academic and co-academic matters in/outside the class and act as mentor whereas $4 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $54 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher/mentor also guides for higher academic pursuits and career advancements whereas $4 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $58 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher encourages the students for participation and discussion in the class (teacher- student, studentstudent) whereas none of the students disagrees.
- $38 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher encourages the students for healthy discussion even if they disagree with him/her whereas $4 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $42 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher pays attention to academically weaker students as well and gives extra time after the class whereas $8 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $50 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher relates the course material with real world situations whereas none disagrees.
- $24 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher uses latest ICT tools like Smart Boards, Projectors, Charts etc. while teaching whereas $34 \%$ of the students are neutral.
- $52 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher's attitude towards the students was friendly \& helpful whereas $2 \%$ disagrees.
- $54 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the periodical assessments are conducted as per schedule whereas none disagrees.
- $52 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher uses non-traditional methods of evaluation like quiz, seminar, assignments, classroom presentations and students participation whereas $6 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $42 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that Question paper covers all the topics in curriculum whereas $2 \%$ of the students disagree.
- $50 \%$ of the students agree to the fact that the teacher is fair and unbiased in the evaluation process whereas $2 \%$ of the students disagrees.
- $44 \%$ of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher has professional competence and is a role model for them whereas $4 \%$ of the students disagree.
