Keeping this view point in mind feedback form was filled by students on teaching learning process. From analysis it was found that majority of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher communicates clearly and possesses deep knowledge of the subject, guides the students for higher academic pursuits and career advancements, relates the course material with real world situations, is helpful and friendly towards students and has professional competence and is a role model for them. 82% of the students strongly agree to the fact that teacher covers the entire syllabus whereas none disagrees.


- 54% of the students strongly agree to the fact that teachers covers the entire syllabus

- 51% of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher possesses deep knowledge of the subject taught
- 47.2% of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teachers inspire them by his/her knowledge in the subject
- 51.1% of the students strongly agree to the fact that teacher is punctual to the class.
- 47.1% of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher engages the class for the full duration and completes the course in time
- 52.7% of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher comes fully prepared for the class whereas none of the students disagree.
- 49.2% of the students strongly agree to the fact that the teacher uses latest ICT tools like Smart Boards, Projectors, Charts etc. while teaching whereas 10% of the students are neutral.
- 49.9% of the students agree to the fact that the teacher's attitude towards the students was friendly & helpful whereas none disagrees.
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
- 47.4% of the students agree to the fact that the periodical assessments are conducted as per schedule whereas none disagrees.


10. The teacher encourages participation and discussion in class(Teacher-Student, Student-Student).




11. The teacher uses ICT methods like PPT, Google Classrooms, Whatsapp Groups or other Online Modes for delivering lectures.




12. The teacher pays attention to academically weaker students as well.




13. The teacher relates the course material with real world situations.




14. The teacher's attitude towards the students is friendly and helpful.




15. Periodical assessments are conducted as per schedule.




16. The teacher uses non-traditional methods of evaluation like Quiz, Seminars, Assignments, Class room presentation/participation(Any Other).
