- Any other innovative programme on environmental issues.

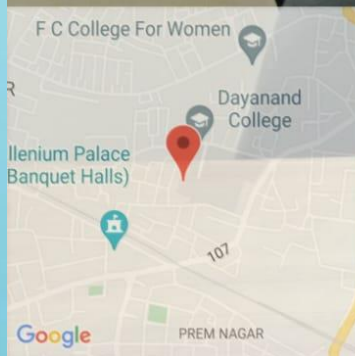
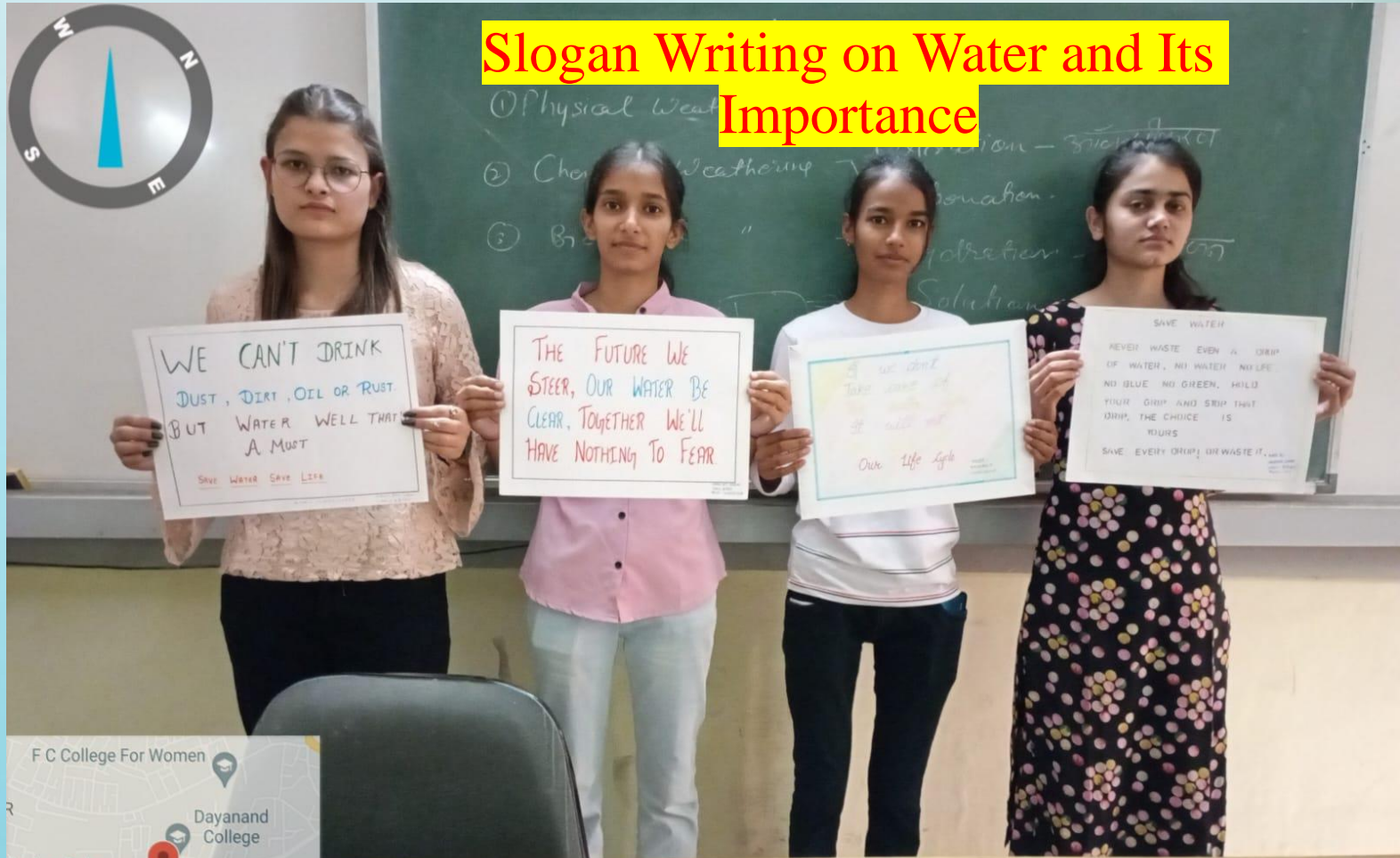


2. A local field visit of **Blue Bird Lake** was organized on **31 March, 2023** for the students to make them aware about regional eco-system and its functioning.

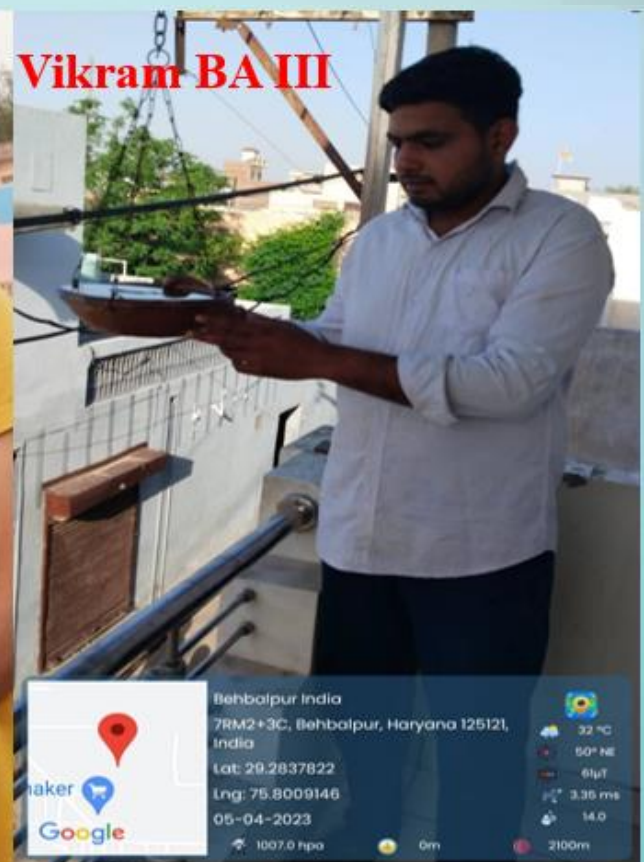
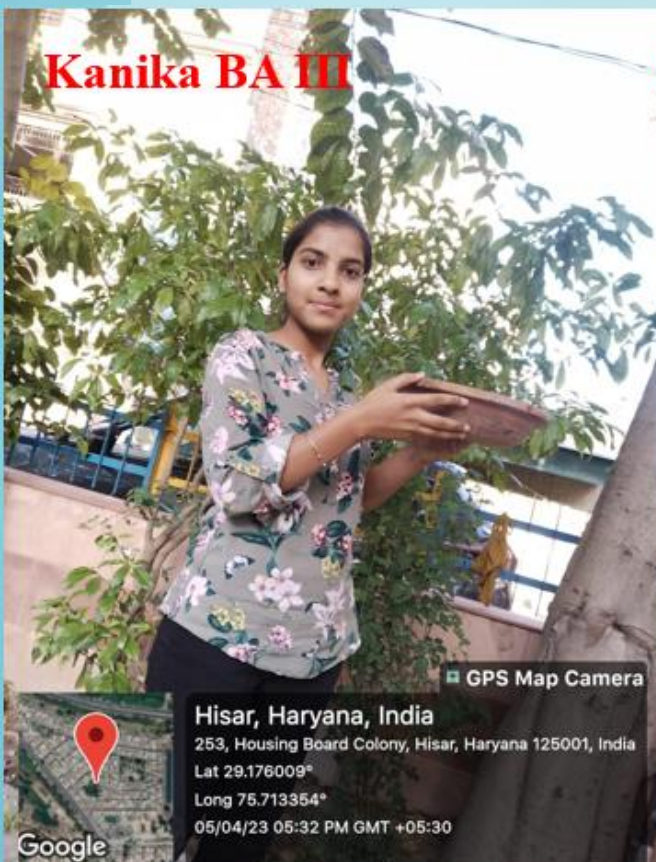
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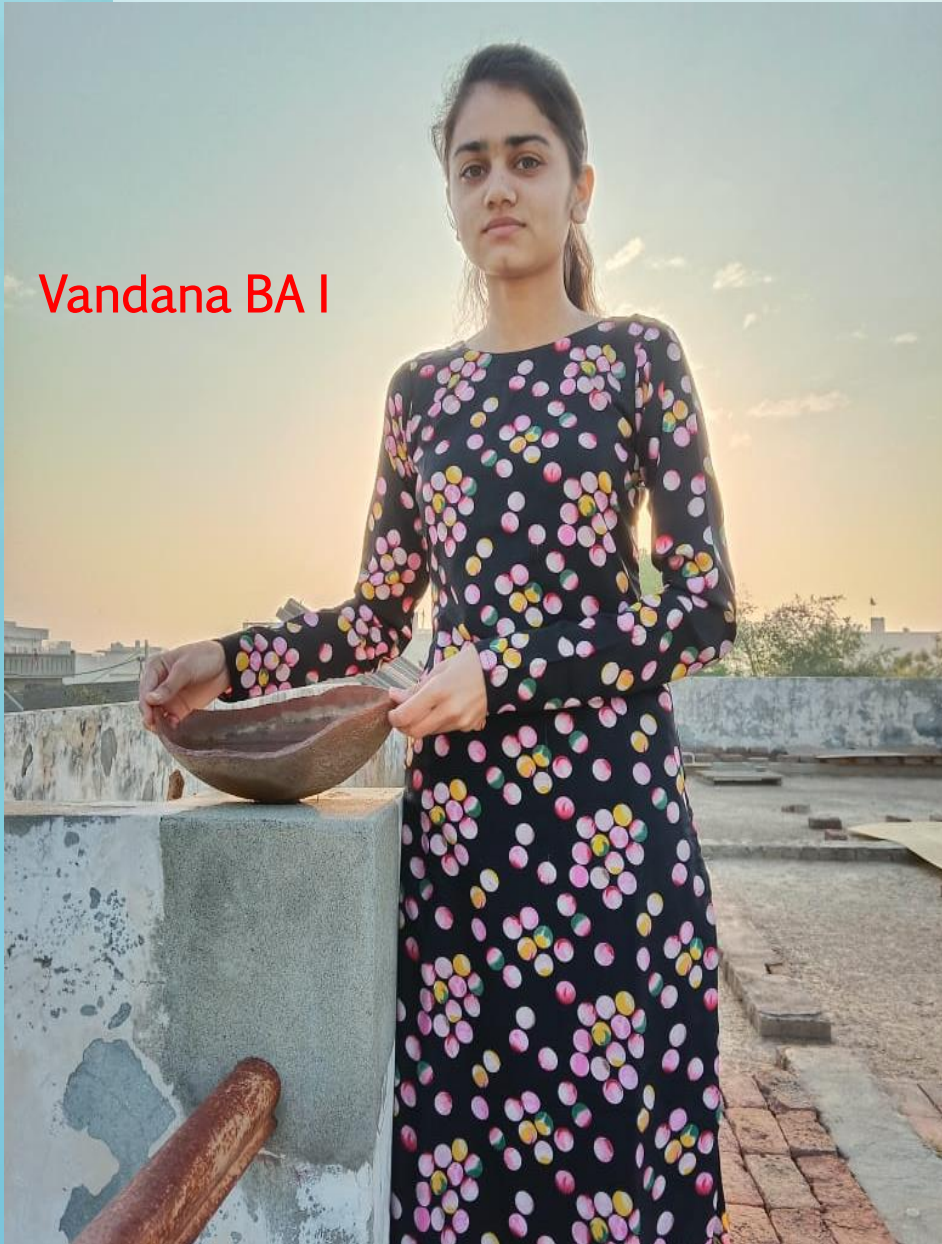
