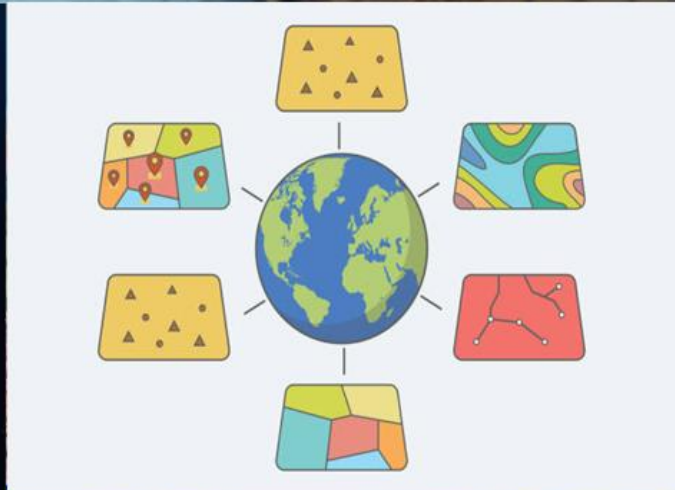
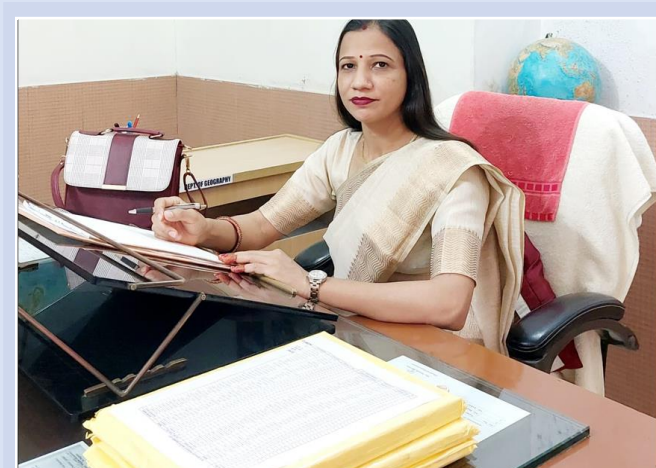


# DAYANAND COLLEGE, HISAR

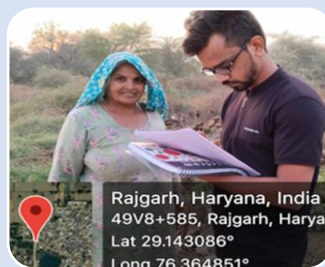

### Learning in the Field: Unleashing Education's Full Potential

Field visits is a method which involves a direct study of a field situation. Field /visits survey is an essential research method in geography which accumulates data places, fragmented landscape people and other phenomena. field survey or survey is an investigation basically a descriptive study done in a field. We organized compulsory educational field trips for M.Sc. (F) and B.A. (F) students for assessing the socio-economic study of selected place.



*A Field Visit for Socio-economic Survey was conducted by the students of M.Sc. 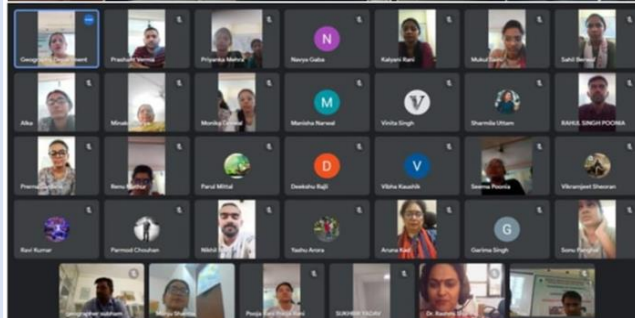

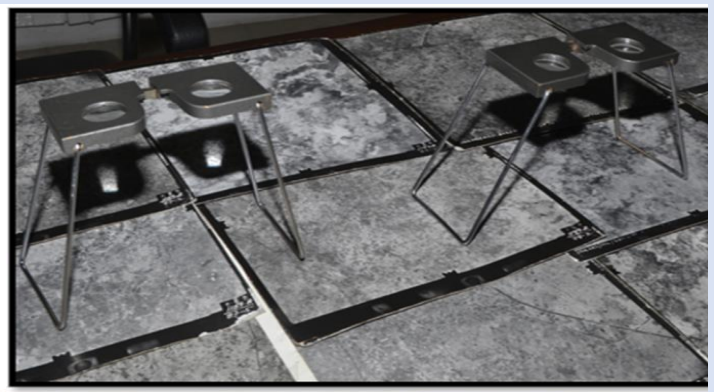
