Jal Shakti Abhiyan:

Inspired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister's movement on Jal Sanchay, Jal Shakti Abhiyan for water conservation and water security is launched by Government of India. The campaign will run through citizen participation during the monsoon season, from 1st July, 2019 to 15th September, 2019. An additional Phase 2 will be run from 1st October, 2019 to 30th November, 2019 for States receiving the North East retreating monsoons. The focus of the campaign will be on water stressed districts and blocks. During the campaign, officers, groundwater experts and scientists from the Government of India will work together with state and district officials in India's most water-stressed districts. The main objectives will be conservation of water and water resource management with rainwater harvesting, renovation of traditional and other water bodies/tanks, reuse, bore well recharge structures, watershed development and intensive afforestation. The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, in his Mann Ki Baat address has given a call to citizens to join hands for water conservation and create a Jan-Andolan along the lines of the Swachh Bharat Mission, to save water and secure the future.
