Policy Statement/Vision



Policy Objectives

The Objectives of Policy are :-

1. To promote holistic approach among faculty staff and students about the waste management in the campus.
2. To educate and provide teaching for staff and students waste material issues.
3. To ensure the safe handling segregation and storage of waste.
4. To promote awareness in order to increase and encourage waste minimization by reuse and recycle of waste.
5. To follow the five "R" principles of Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Refuse and Regenerate.
6. To provide clearly defined roles and responsibilities in order to identify and coordinate and activity of waste management.
7. To minimize the use of plastic and plastic products in the campus.

Action Plan for Solid Waste Management


1. Measures shall be taken for minimal and optional use of papers.
2. E-billing is promoted to reduce the use of paper.
3. Use of proper clips in place of staples is encouraged.
4. All one side used papers shall be utilized for routine printing activities.
5. Use of plastic and polythene bags is minimized in the campus by staffs and students.
6. Dustbin system is employed for segregation of Solid Waste.
7. Blue and green dustbins are used for dry and biodegradable waste.
8. Every day waste is carried away by Municipal Corporation, Hisar for recycling and productive use.
9. Cleaning and emptying of dustbins is ensured at regular intervals on daily basis.
10. Ball point pens shall be put to reuse by inserting new refill in the same pen.

MoU


1. An MoU will be signed by the college with an NGO or other outside agency for recycling of solid waste, generated in the College and Hostel Campus.
2. According to this MoU - The waste will be collected, segregated and carried away by the NGO and in return of solid waste, they may deposit some nominal amount in the college.
3. Trainings and Workshops of students and service staff will be organized.
4. Rallies and other awareness programmes will be organized for solid waste management.
5. Poster Making and Slogan Writing Competitions will be organized to create awareness among students and staffs.
